



Bubble Soccer Fact Sheet

We can offer your club use of our Bubble Soccer set. It can be used as a way to fundraise or just for a fun club activity. There are 12 bubble balls.

Bookings are to be made directly to the Student Engagement and Events Team via the info@yourimbah.com.au email.

Conditions

- We require that at least two club members to sign the bottom of this fact sheet, agreeing to our conditions for booking the Bubble Soccer.
- At least two club members must meet the Student Engagement and Event Staff members to be inducted as to proper use of the Bubble Soccer. The Staff member will supervise the set-up and pack-down.
- At least one inducted club member must supervise the game play and ensure players sign the waiver before use.
- If irreparable damage is done to the balls the club may be liable to repair costs.
- All players must sign the liability waiver before entering the ball.

Sessions

- The Bubble Soccer can be booked for sessions of 3 hours which must allow sufficient time for set up and pack down. It takes approximately 30-40 minutes to inflate the balls and approximately 15-20 minutes to clean and deflate.
- The sessions can only run between the business hours of 9am-4pm during weekdays.

Cleaning & Maintenance

- Sanitary wipes are provided to clean the balls in between uses.
- A puncture repair kit is stored in the Equipment Box.

Transport & Storage

- Bubble Soccer is stored at the Yourimbah Office –The balls must be carried to and from the Quad. This can be done by wearing the ball and walking carefully to the middle of the Quad.
- Arrange for several volunteer club members to assist with carrying the balls.
- Balls must be cleaned, dried and fully deflated – they must then be rolled and put back into the store room for storage along with the Equipment Box.

Playing

- All watches, rings, earrings, belts or any other pointy, metal or personal item that could potentially damage the bubble balls must be removed and placed in the box provided.
- Players must be wearing the ball correctly (logo at the bottom/head must not pop out the top and straps secured properly)
- No contact is allowed with a player who is already on the ground. There is an increased risk of injury as players try to stand to regain their balance and are contacted while trying to stand.

Bubble Soccer Checklist

- Book a Bubble Soccer time slot.
- Receive email confirmation from Yourimbah of booking
- Have Bubble Soccer Fact Sheet signed and submitted to Student Engagement and Events Team
- Decide charging price for donations
- Promote the event to your club
- Arrange for several members to assist in carrying the bubbles to the Oval
- Meet with a Student Engagement and Events Staff member who will supervise the set-up/pack-down
- Bubble Soccer Waivers signed and send to the Student Engagement and Events team (we can print some off for you)
- Delegate an inducted Bubble Soccer supervisor for the duration of the session
- During use of the Bubble soccer use wipes to clean the ball in between players using them
- After the session carry the Bubble Soccer back to the storeroom and pack away. Ensure that the Equipment Box is stocked with its required items.

Bubble Soccer Equipment Box Checklist

- A pump (and charge cord)
- Earmuffs (for use with the pump)
- 12 orange cones to mark your playing field
- A box with whistles and disinfectant wipes
- Puncture repair kit
- A box for your players to leave watches, rings, earrings, belts or any other pointy, metal or personal item that could potentially damage the bubble balls.
